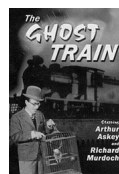


**BARMOUTH BRIDGE 150th / THE GHOST TRAIN (U, 93") 13 - 15 OCTOBER**



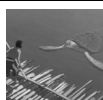
